There has been changes in OSHA rules and regulations regarding Powered Industrial Trucks (PIT). Anyone who operates a forklift, or any form of PIT is required to attend a forklift safety course and obtain certification that they understand how to safely operate a PIT. A refresher course is required every three years. Fines of up to \$7,000.00 per uncertified person can be assessed.

Learn new rules and regulations regarding the safe use of PIT in the workplace. See examples of how a certain rule or regulation pertains to a given scenario.
